KANS undertakes cleaning drive near Basava temple

KRISHNAGIRI: The Hosur-based Kenneth Anderson Nature Society (KANS) undertook an intensive cleaning drive near Basava temple located on the banks of the River Cauvery at Dabguli in Urigam ranger of Hosur forest division recently.

According to a release from the Society, devotees visiting the temple during Shivarathri festival litter the place causing inconvenience to the public.

The nature society urged the organising committee of the festival to ask the public to use biodegradable arecanut leaf plates.

Following lack of fund with the organising committee, the KANS came forward to bear 50 per cent of the expense and sourced 30,000 arecanut leaf plates.

The festival committee dug up pits to dump the used leaf plates and the garbage.

To create awareness among the devotees to use biodegradable food plates and cups, volunteers from KANS were deputed to put sign boards and collect waste.

Jute bags were also placed at several places to collect waste.

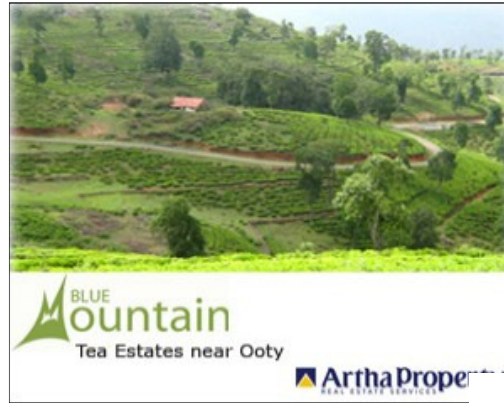
